\* A 5<sup>th</sup> dose of Td not required if child completed the 4<sup>th</sup> dose during or after age 4. In addition, the student must have a tetanus booster current within the last 10 years.

\*\*4<sup>th</sup> dose of Polio not required if the child completed the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose during or after age 4

\*\*\*Parental verification that the child had chicken pox is acceptable instead of the vaccine

\*\*\*\*Student ages 11-15 only need a 2-dose series of Hepatitis B. All other ages must receive 3 doses.
